Admissions reply scenarios and what to do in each case

Scenarios	e-candidat admissions notification	Student Preference	What you need to do in e-candidate
Scenario 1	I have been admitted to my 1 st choice (1er vœu) program but I am not wait-listed for any other choices	I would like to enroll in the program to which I have been admitted	Accept admission via e-candidat before the final acceptance deadline
Scenario 2	I have been wait-listed for 1 or more of my program choices but have not been admitted to any of the programs	I would like to maintain all of my application choices	Wait (you may be admitted in one of the following notification batches)
Scenario 3	I have been wait-listed for my 1 st and/or 2 nd choices AND I have been admitted to one of my lower-priority choices	I would like to maintain my top priority applications and remain on the waitlist for them AND I would like to "play it safe" by accepting admission to one of my lower-priority choices	For your top choices: Wait (you may be admitted in one of the following notification batches) AND For your lower priority choice: Accept admission via e-candidat before the final acceptance deadline
		I do not want to maintain my top priority applications and I would like to withdraw from the waitlist BUT I would like the program to which I have been admitted to be considered as my 1 st choice	Delete my application in e-candidat for the programs where I am wait-listed AND Accept admission to the lower priority program to which I have been accepted via e-candidat before the final acceptance deadline
